



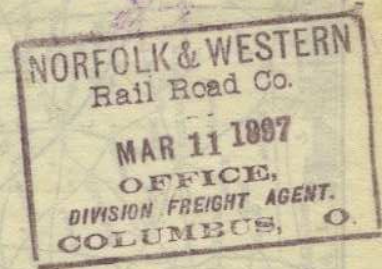

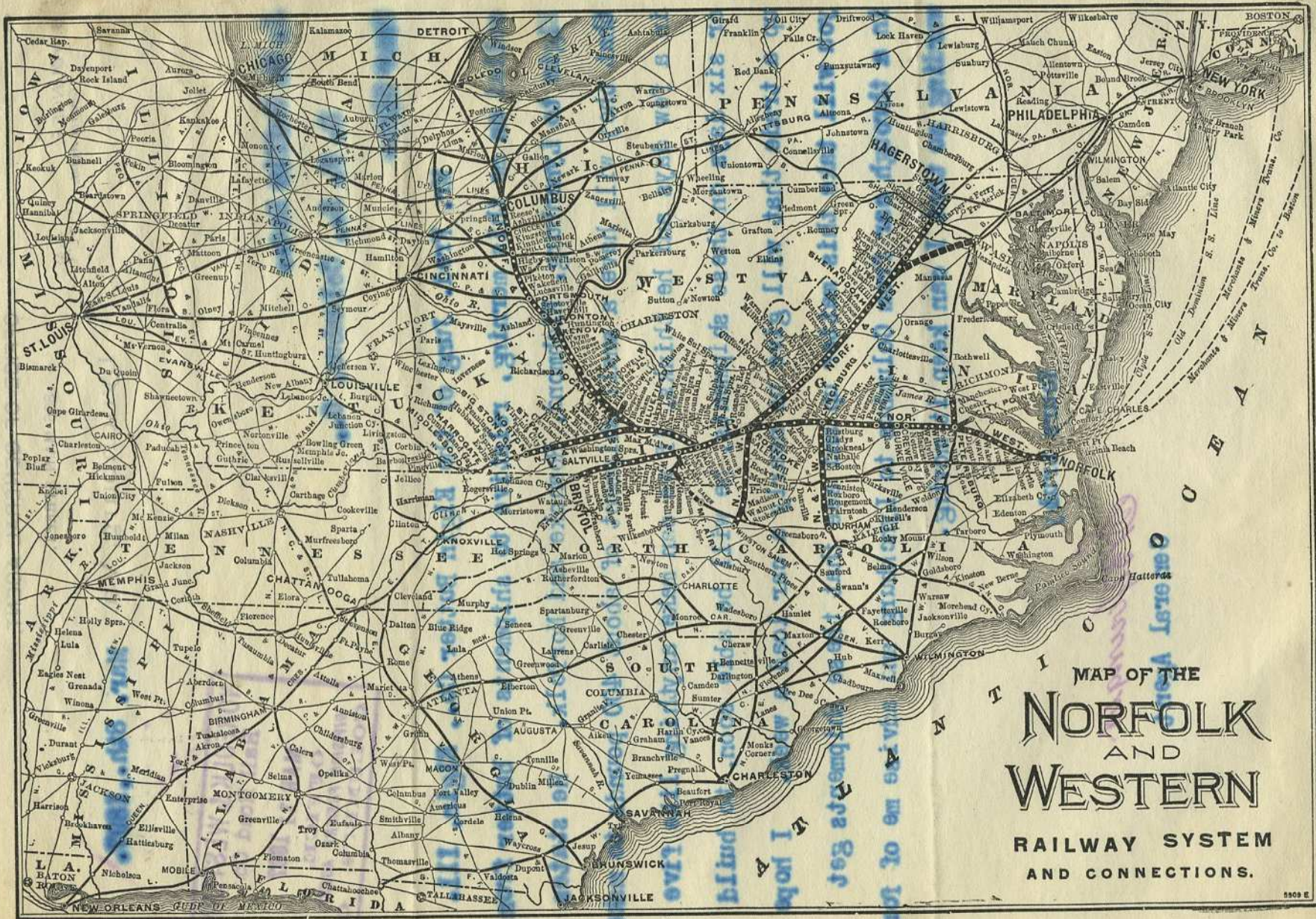
Dear Sir:-
